# LEAVE OF ABSENCE – CRITICAL ILLNESS, CHILD DEATH, CRIME-RELATED CHILD DISAPPEARANCE

#### POLICY:

According to the "Fair Workplaces, Better Jobs Act (2017)" employees are entitled to take an unpaid, job-protected leave related to the above reasons.

#### **PURPOSE:**

When employees have been employed for at least six months, the employee may take a leave as outlined by the Ministry of Labour in the Employment Standards Act.

### PROCEDURE:

- Critical Illness Leave for minor child entitled to maximum 37 weeks unpaid leave
- Critical Illness Leave for adult entitled to maximum of 17 weeks unpaid leave
- Child Death Leave entitled to maximum 104 weeks unpaid leave
- Crime-Related Child Disappearance Leave entitled to a maximum of 104 weeks unpaid leave
