MEDICAL DIRECTOR

POLICY:

The Medical Director will provide advice to the Senior Management and the IPAC Lead of the Home regarding immunization programs, contagious diseases, and infection prevention and control policies and procedures, and will maintain a professional relationship with hospitals and other agencies.

PROCEDURE:

The Medical Director will:

- 1) Act as a resource to the IPAC Lead.
- 2) Participate on the Infection Prevention & Control Committee.
- 3) Communicate any relevant information to attending physicians/nurse practitioners associated with the Home.
- 4) Communicate with the Public Health Unit as required and make recommendations regarding any testing that should be completed.
- 5) Issue medical directives specific to immunizations and outbreaks for all residents in the Home.
