GASTRONOMY TUBE FLUSHING

POLICY:

RN's will flush the resident's gastrostomy tube after feeding and as ordered by the Physician.

PROCEDURE:

Ensure that you are speaking with the resident to avoid anxiety with the procedure.

- 1. Turn off the enteral pump.
- 2. Close the roller clamp.
- 3. Disconnect the feeding tube from the gastrostomy tube connector.
- 4. Using a 60 cc catheter tip syringe, flush with 90 cc of room temperature water.
- 5. Remove the syringes and close the connector cap in place.
 - a. Discard the 60 cc syringes every 3 days. Date the syringe to ensure it is not used passed the 3 days. You may use 2 syringes, filling 40 cc in the first syringe and 50 cc in the second syringe to reach the 90 cc amount.
