CLEANING HIGH-TOUCH SURFACES

POLICY:

To ensure the proper disinfection and cleanliness of high-touch surfaces throughout the Learnington Mennonite Home. High-touch surfaces include but are not limited to door handles, light switches, handrails, telephones, elevator buttons, and countertops.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The Housekeeping staff will wipe down high-touch surfaces once daily at minimum and twice daily during an outbreak.
- 2. Housekeeping staff will use a microfiber cloth that has been soaked in the disinfectant Oxivir Plus solution to clean these surfaces. Surfaces are to remain wet with Oxivir Plus for 5 minutes for proper contact time.
- 3. When finished with use, the cloth will be laundered.
- 4. During outbreak, housekeeping staff are to document on *High Touch Surface Cleaning Logs* that additional cleaning was completed in isolation rooms and common areas.
- 5. Cloth buckets are also available for all staff at any time for extra cleaning purposes.
- 6. Cloths are not to be "double dipped" into the Oxivir disinfectant solution.
