PETS: HOME & COMPLEX

POLICY:

The Leamington Mennonite Home is a community of care which strives to provide quality of life to all residents in the Long Term Care Home, Retirement Residence, and Complex. In order to provide a safe and healthy care environment, pets may not reside in the Care Homes, Retirement Residence, Apartments, and Condominiums.

PROCEDURE:

In instances where a pet has served as a demonstrated companion to a Townhouse resident, prior to a Townhouse acquisition, that pet may accompany the residents, provided that the following conditions are met:

- The pet shall be defined as one cat, or dog, no greater than 25 pounds. Multiple pets shall not be allowed and pets cannot be replaced.
- A Pet Registration and Consent Form process shall be completed by the Townhouse resident including:
 - A pet registration fee in the amount of \$300.00.
 - Annual veterinary certificate of vaccination(s) and immunization(s).
 - Annual registration of municipal pet licence.
 - A written and signed Plan of Care for the pet in case of resident emergencies to be updated annually.

Failure to complete the Pet Registration and Consent Form process shall result in non-acceptance of the pet in the Townhouse dwelling.

- The Leamington Mennonite Home shall give written notice to a Townhouse Resident to remove the pet from the premises if the pet:
 - Becomes aggressive or disobedient.
 - Creates a disturbance for neighbours, visitors, and/or care givers.
 - Leaves messes/debris on any Townhouse premise.

As determined by the Leamington Mennonite Home: Administration

The Home shall charge any and all damages caused by the pet, while residing in the Townhouse, to the Townhouse owner and upon the need for repairs and/or the resale of the unit. The Leamington Mennonite Home shall maintain the sole right to:

- Determine cost of any/all damages caused by the pet.
- Request payment for damages caused by the pet while the unit is occupied or vacated by the resident.
- Devalue the unit upon sale as determined by the Home.

Devalue the unit upon sale of occupancy as determined by the Home. Ote: Any unpaid charges will be deducted from the final payment for the unit to the resident/family
