**DIETARY INFECTION CONTROL GENERAL PRACTICE GUIDELINES**

**POLICY:**

Dietary staff will prepare and deliver food in a manner that ensures safety and prevents potential for food-acquired illnesses.

**PROCEDURE:**

The Dietary staff will:

- 1) Follow general practice guidelines that support infection prevention and control.
- 2) Follow HACCP (Hazard Analysis Critical Control Points).
- 3) Comply with all relevant legislation, regulations, and staff education regarding infection prevention and control, e.g., hand hygiene, storing, handling, preparation and serving of food and beverages, cleaning and disinfection of food service surfaces and equipment.
