## MOBILITY ASSESSMENT

## **POLICY:**

To ensure that there is an organized program of therapy service or arrangements are made to access available therapy services to meet residents identified therapy needs.

#### PROCEDURE:

- The adjuvant will facilitate a comprehensive resident mobility assessment within 14 days of admission to the Leamington Mennonite Home. After completion of the assessment, a resident specific action plan will be developed.
- Bayshore Inc. rehabilitation physiotherapy services are available for all residents referred by the home's physician. The P.T. will assess the residents needs and provide a plan of care and goals to:
  - Improve Range of Motion (ROM)
  - Improve transfer skills
  - Improve dynamic balance
  - Improve walking distance
  - Reduce risk for falls
  - Maintain strength
  - Residents are reviewed on a quarterly basis by the P.T. and the Home's physician.
- The Windsor-Essex CCAC: Occupational Therapy Department will be consulted for additional assessment for those residents with the following needs:
  - Mobility Aid responsive to resident specific condition
  - Adaptive utensils for daily living activities.
  - o Comfort/rehabilitation resources such as splints, cushions, etc.
- The adjuvant will complete a quarterly review of each resident's scope of mobility consistent with the review of the resident's care plan. Information is reviewed at the annual care plan meeting (multidisciplinary) which resident/representatives are encouraged to attend. When risk factors are identified. A request is made for a P.T. referral/review.

- The adjuvant will provide the liaise between the resident, resident family, and Physio/Occupational Therapists. Specifically, the adjuvant will assist with the following:
  - Notify resident and resident families of Physio/Occupational Therapy Assessments, providing relevant information/education.
  - o Interpret recommendations made by the Physio and Occupational Therapists.
  - Assist resident and resident families in the implementation of recommendations, providing information in the ordering of equipment and subsequent resident orientation and training for that equipment.
  - Monitor effectiveness of implemented recommendations, action plan and/or equipment usage.
