## MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION PER GASTRONOMY TUBE

#### **POLICY:**

Residents requiring medication administration per gastrostomy tube will be carefully monitored by the Registered Staff.

### **PURPOSE:**

To provide and administer medication via gastrostomy tube.

### **EQUIPMENT:**

- Liquid medication as ordered by the Physician, or crushed and mixed with water (check that meds can be crushed).
- 60 ml syringe.
- Room temperature water for flushing.

# PROCEDURE:

- 1. Wash hands and assist the resident to a sitting position.
- 2. Flush gastrostomy with 30 cc room temperature water per syringe.
- 3. Administer dosage of liquid medication, as ordered by the Physician, per syringe into the gastrostomy tube.
- 4. Flush gastrostomy tube with 60 cc room temperature water per syringe.
- 5. Follow this procedure for each medication to be administered.
