RAI MDS 2.0 INITIAL CARE PLAN

POLICY:

The Leamington Mennonite Home will ensure that each new resident will have a computerized RAI MDS initial plan of care within 21 days of admission. The care plan will be completed by the RAI MDS Coordinator in collaboration with the multidisciplinary team. The information will be gathered from the RAI assessments, flow sheets, CCAC profile, nurse's notes, the resident and/or family members.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Using the RAI MDS 2.0 timelines the admission full assessment will be completed by day 21.
- The RAI MDS Coordinator will input all data into the computer and produce a hard copy
 of the care plan which will replace the 24 hour admission care plan in the HCA flow
 sheet binder. This provides convenient and immediate access to the resident's plan of
 care.
- 3. The computerized care plan will encompass the diagnosis and all risks (to self and others), behaviours, abilities, preferences, needs, goals, diet, treatments and medications of the resident.
- 4. The RAI MDS Coordinator will use the appropriate timelines to complete the quarterly, annual and significant change in status assessments to update the plan of care.
- 5. The Registered Staff will add to the hard copy care plan when there is a change in status, the plan is no longer affective or goals have been met.
- 6. The MDS RAI Coordinator will update the computerized care plan of any changes at the next quarterly assessment and replace the hard copy.
